Chief Jack delivered the Police report to the Board. There were 40 summonses and 67 incident reports filed within the past month.

Village Administrator's Report

Gail Devol delivered her report to the Board. As of March 21, 2023, all taxes have been paid. One (1) tax lien was sold. 2023-24 tax bills will be mailed out mid-May.

Best Poison Ivy, Inc. has completed the cleaning of Buxton Cove.

Foncho, our landscaper, will clean the gabion within the next couple weeks.

Four additional dog waste stations have been installed on Vineyard Road, Nathan Hale Beach, Bay Ave/Beaux Arts, and by Buxton Cove.

Refunds for snow removal is being returned to the associations this week.

Road Commissioner's Report

Mark Dara delivered his report to the Board. He spoke of a new drain installed on Bay Ave. had incurred damage from abandoned water pipes causing it to collapse due to an improper mark-out by Suffolk County Water Authority. SCWA will pay for the repairs.

Financials

The financial reports have been made available to the Board.

After review, questions, and discussion, a motion was made by Jay Meyer to approve the March 2023 list of bills, it was seconded by Don Rave and unanimously approved 4-0.

Mayor's Report

Mayor Morrow delivered his report to the Board. The Mayor discussed that due to the fact that the State has not yet adopted their budget, Huntington Bay's budget will not be finalized and voted on until the May 8th Board meeting.
