Mark Dara delivered his report to the Board. He stated that Action Blacktop put a berm on Bay Road to mitigate the water situation. Street cleaning is complete. This year the drain cleaning will include Wincoma, which has not been done in several years.

Mayor Morrow commented on East Shore Road and the possibility of widening the road. A survey of the road will be done by the Village soon.

## Mayor's Report

Mayor Morrow delivered his report to the Board. He stated that hand sanitizers have been installed by Ron Scarlett at the four beach club buildings. He thanked Danielle Catanese for her help with the purchasing and organizing the project.

Zoning Board meetings will resume in July.

The organizational meeting will occur in October.

Taxes were mailed out with a note regarding the July 21, 2020 extension date.
